Soberfest – Est. Cost to TCIO: \$4,008.50 (expenses) - \$1,445.00 (cash donations) = \$2,563.50

Total attendance: 325 attendees Photo booth: \$292.50; Venue \$1300; Catering - \$2100 (estimate); Wristbands \$116; Misc – approx. \$200 spent Approx. total expenses: \$4,008.50; Donations at door - \$1645; Cash given to TCIO - \$1445 Donations included: \$10 suggested donations, 50/50 raffle, and wristband sales - \$1

Expenses paid from donations: \$50 – bottled water, \$150 – Pelican snow cone truck Snow cone truck was about \$300 - we had a member donate expenses over \$150; Chairs were borrowed from local church – moved by U-Haul truck, U-Haul cost/rental donated by member ESTIMATED COST TO TCIO: \$4,008.50 (expenses) - \$1,445.00 (cash donations) = \$2,563.50 Approximately 325 people in attendance! We had people attending from all over SC and GA!
