What Do We Do?

- Responsible for oversight of the AA Hotline.
- Serves as the Group Conscience for the Tri-County area to make decisions related to the staffing of the hotline.
- Provide service work and support to those seeking help.

"I am responsible, when anyone, anywhere, reaches out for help, I want the hand of AA always to be there, and for that I am responsible."



Team Member Responsibilities

- Regularly attend each Communication meeting (one-hour duration).
- Each group providing coverage for the hotline should have a Communication Representative that will be the primary point of contact.
- The Communication representative for each group staffing the hotline is responsible for:
 - Ensuring their assigned shift is covered
 - Providing the person staffing the hotline with information needed to cover the shift
 - Notifying the TCIO Communication Chairperson when his/her communication service commitment (term) ends and who will be the new representative for that group
 - Knowledge of the TCIO website and how to locate documents related to the Communication team to ensure each group has the most up to date information

Hotline: How it Works

- Offers 24/7 support to anyone dialing the number printed on the back of our white chip.
 - TCIO recommends 90 days of sobriety to staff the hotline.
 - Supported by various groups in the Tri-County area from 7am-11pm.
 - A professional answering service covers from 11pm-7am.
- Helping people find meetings and connect with the AA community.
- Other services may include:
 - 12-Step calls.
 - Rides to meetings.
 - Transportation to treatment centers.
 - Getting someone connected to other alcoholics in a specific area.

Hotline Process

- Call in to get report from previous person staffing the hotline.
- Call the answering service to have the service transferred to your phone.
- You represent Alcoholics Anonymous to anyone that may call in!!
 - Both your number and the caller's number are "blocked" as part of the forwarding process.
 - If you chose to maintain your anonymity when returning a call, you can block your number by dialing *67 then their number with the area code.
 - Be sure you have the current meeting schedule handy in case you need to help the caller find a meeting.
 - If a 12-step call or visit is needed, get the caller's first name, phone number and location, then use the 12-step list provided to locate someone of the same sex in their area to contact individual.
- You should receive a call from the next volunteer at the end of your shift unless your shift ends at 11pm.


