PI/CPC Report: Charlene C.

Once these have played, the intergroup and district can decide if we want to continue paying for these PSA's from our own budget. There will be more details on which radio station and what times these will be playing next week. The next PICPC meeting is September 15th at 2:30pm. PICPC will decide whether or not to continue doing such with radio airing and if so, they will decide how frequently that will be.

#### **Treatment Report; Kevin O.**

Kevin reported that all treatment commitments are currently filled and there are no issues nor updates other than that.
