However, it was clarified that the Chair and the Alt-Chair are over the Prudent Reserve, according to the ByLaws. It was clarified that the old prudent reserve needs transferred to the new prudent account which cannot be done by Kathleen based on the mentioned ByLaws. However, it was stated that until the account is switched to a new Chair/Alt-Chair, the funds in the old prudent reserve are not accessible.**
