Communications Report: Jennifer

Events Report: Paul C.

There was no report provided during the meeting.

PI/CPC Report: Charlene C.

It is reported that a few people went to the Lowcountry Mental Health conference to sit at a table for PICPC and pass out pamphlets and information about AA. PI/CPC are working on connecting with local nursing schools to see how we can be of service to their nursing students. Charlene reported that next month in September will be her last meeting as chair of PICPC before moving out of state. Charlene believes that she has found a replacement who is willing to take over her position for the rest of the year. The next PICPC meeting is on September 21 at 2:30 at the TCIO office.

Treatment Report; Kevin O.

Treatment had their meeting last month in July where there are more volunteers currently than there are commitments to be filled.

Kevin reported that a treatment commitment was added for commitments (Seagrove in Mt. Pleasant) and that a treatment commitment was also lost (Star Gospel Mission) as well. Kevin denied it being any fault other than Star Gospel Mission wanting to go their own way and not have AA involved.

Web Master Report: Andy B.

There was no report provided during the meeting.

There was concern presented about the Web Page needing to be updated but has not been done as of yet. It was stated that there is content needing to be updated, and it remains unknown if meeting information needs to be updated. The ByLaws were referenced and clarified that if a board member misses 3 or more meetings, then it is grounds for a replacement to be sought. It was stated that the current Web Master would be thanked for the time thus far but that the position is now vacant to be filled.

It was sought for the information to be taken back to the groups in order to seek for a replacement.

Raymond reported that he would be willing to fill the Web Master position in the interim.

Office Manager: Bill W.

Bill reported that in order to fill the basic needs of the office, 12 volunteers are needed for the office schedule. He stated that so far, there are 11 volunteers. He reported that Saturday is filled due to it only being one shift, however, the rest of the days have 2 shifts.

He reported that throughout the week that there are only 3 shifts needing filled by volunteers. Bill reported that the shift still needing to be filled is Friday morning, Monday afternoon and Wednesday afternoon.

Bill stated that there are temporary time slots needing to be filled. The time slot for Wednesday morning needs a temporary Bill reported that the Friday

afternoon shift volunteer will need filled possibly long term but most certainly short term due to the volunteer currently for that time slot having surgery.

Bill reported that there are 4 more volunteers needed to help at the office with the shift vacancies.

Bill alerted that there is a homeless person that frequents the area that is very aggressive and will come into the office demanding money. He notified this for any volunteers to remain vigilant.

Bill reported that the office is currently out of large print and hard covered Big Books at this moment. However, he reported that he recently ordered more of both and they will be on the shelves as soon as available.
