Communications Report

Jennifer W. Communications Chair gave her Communications Report.

Jennifer stated that she had completed and updated the phone schedule.

Jennifer is having trouble getting groups to turn in their volunteer phone list in a timely manner. Jennifer stated it takes time to make the schedule and requested prompt delivery so that there is no delay in creating the phone schedule.

Old business:

At the December TCIO meeting, new business was brought up to change our bylaws from voting by quorum to majority vote.

No quorum was met at the previous 3 meetings which created a problem with assigning new board positions and other business. Dakota S. explained how quorum number is configured to pass votes according to our current bylaws.

Quorum requires 2/3 of the last 2 meetings attendance count present to pass a vote.

Some concerns were raised about group attendance drastically declining for over a year.

Attendees expressed various points of view about TCIO rep participation. Majority present were interested in changing the bylaw for voting.

Per our bylaws, written proposition to amend bylaws must be written and signed by no less than three board members and submitted through meeting minutes to all groups with a 45-day waiting period after signed submission before this vote can be brought to the floor to make the amendment valid.

Present attendees decided to write the amendment request and send to all TCIO reps for the 45-day waiting period.

Dakota S. volunteered to submit it in writing. Three board members signed the requested amendment.

Attendee asked to allow zoom TCIO rep participation.

Discussed the need to restart zoom access for TCIO Rep participation as a way to increase attendance for monthly TCIO meetings.

Dan G. volunteered to be online admin and set up zoom online access to TCIO meetings to help with meeting attendance. The link will be provided before the next monthly TCIO meeting.

Discussed changing verbiage of "in-person" TCIO meetings on website to include "online" zoom also.

Attendee asked if we have the amount that each group contributes and spends monthly? This information would be used to see how much a group contributes and how much they spend. Further discussion on how to update and keep record of group contributions and expenses will be discussed among TCIO board members and brought up at our next TCIO monthly meeting.

Attendee asked the board to provide a zoom link for our next TCIO meeting when we send out minutes.

Iris volunteered for Events Coordinator position.

Chad G - Chair and Rosemary H- Alternate Chair will take nominations to appoint a new Events Coordinator. Please email or call TCIO office to submit names and phone numbers for any nominations to be given. You can also bring your nominee or give your nomination at the next TCIO meeting. Understand, this is an appointed position and can be appointed at any time by the Chair.
